

## **Discussion Items:**

## Skatepark

- 1). Pumptrack cost \$35,000 75,000.00. Good for all ages and would bring families to Weston to use. Current trend for Pumptrack Tours.
- 2). Pro Series powder coated steel base with all fasteners hidden, special tool required for disassembly. 20 year warranty and is good for all ages.
- 3). Much lower cost than full concrete construction.
- 4). Refer to Brochure: Sample #6159 Cost would be \$100,000.00, concrete pad would already be poured. Sample #6147 Cost would be \$250,000.00, concrete pad would already be poured.
- 5). These are municipal grade and there is a Pro Series Park in Kennewick WA.
- 6). Concrete Specs 4" pour with 8" edge with a 1% grade for runoff.

- 2006 Skate Park is badly damaged, the repair patches are gone
- The temporary fix has caused the base to become uneven and cracked
- Measurements 4150 ft perimeter 8004 sq ft (92'x87' estimate)
- Looking at third party to design and build.
- 1). American Ramp Company, located in the Ozarks/Project Manager Mattie, Traditional or Street style. Above ground pre-cast concrete would cost \$300,000-400,000.00.
- 2). Spohn Ranch, located in L.A. CA.
- 3). SPA Skate Parks, located in Austin, TX.
- 4). Evergreen Skate Parks, located in Portland, OR.
- Current concrete pad is 3" thick, there were no codes or standards in 2006 when constructed. It must be updated to 4" pour with 8" on perimeter.
