4a) Old Post Office (110 ½ E Main): No action taken.

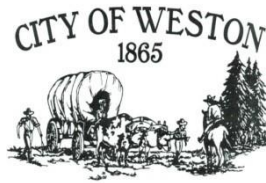
5) Action Items:
