4b) Zoning/Ordinance Revision check-in: No action taken.

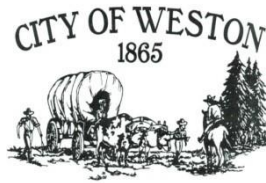
5) Action Items:
