


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Summer Reading Begins!

Summer Reading 2024

The Summer Reading Program theme for 2024 is Read, Renew, Repeat. This is similar to the slogan Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, so we are doing craft projects in the park this summer that explore using cheap and free art supplies made from recycled materials found around the house. Thursday, June 13th, we will make some paper towel roll crafts that may surprise you with their beauty. Tuesday, June 18th at 2:30pm, Traveling Lantern Theatre Company presents The Quest For the Kakapo. They describe the show: Crikey! Join the Caterpillar Hunter on another exciting adventure as he travels around the world to rescue a rare endangered parrot known as the Kakapo, from New Zealand. His globe trotting quest teaches him (and the audience) about the many efforts underway to preserve precious habitats and protect the endangered species that live in them. Then on the following Thursday, June 20th, we host the Dragon Theater Puppets at 1pm. They are offering us their show The Super Silly Circus. The Ringmaster tries to have the greatest circus on the earth. But everything goes wrong, the elephants keep falling over, the lion is on the loose and the clowns run amuck. But the show must go on. They must find a way to renew and repeat the acts correctly. In the end they will find out how to recycle and save the circus.

And that is just the first month of Summer Reading! We will have the usual book log, just color in a circle for every 15 minutes read then turn in the log when finished. Every log turned in gets a choice of sticker. No limit on number of logs.

Thursdays in the Park With Library is new this year. One Thursday per month, we will have some books to check out, a craft to do, some popsicles to enjoy, and a funny sprinkler to run through! Bring a towel, wear something that can get wet and dirty and covered with craft materials. These days in the park are all ages events, but children must be accompanied by an adult.
