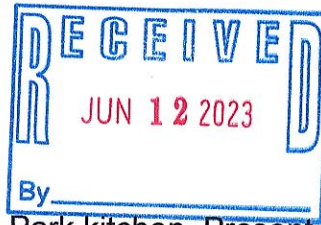


Weston Parks & Recreation Commission
